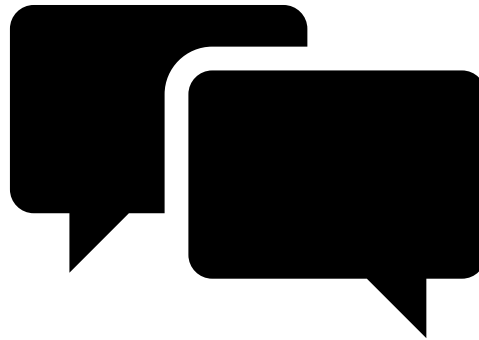
Enhance Communication

Referee communication

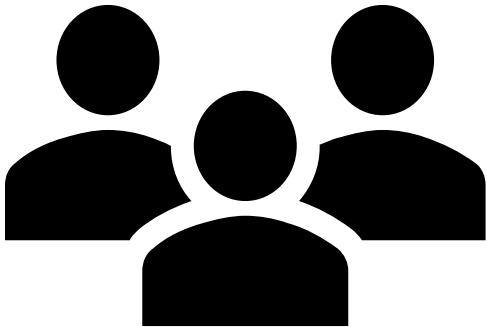
- Develop a referee portal on the website
