

CYSA COMPETITIVE SURCHARGE POLICIES (YOUTH TEAMS)

1. A COMPETITIVE SURCHARGE:

Each member of a CYSA competitive team will be charged a surcharge to help pay for the extra expenses incurred by competitive teams. These extra expenses are incurred because of the following factors:

- Higher costs for better quality travel uniforms and back up uniforms so that the CYSA players look good on the field
- Higher registration costs to the OSA for competitive players
- Play in fees to the various leagues in which CYSA competitive teams participate
- Higher referee (and assistant referee where applicable) costs for competitive games
- Tournament entry fees for the one tournament paid for by the CYSA for youth teams.- Senior teams do not attend tournaments as a rule
- No sponsorships for CYSA competitive teams as directed by board

For the 2012 outdoor season; the competitive surcharge will be as follows:
Each player of a youth competitive team will pay a surcharge of \$50

2. COLLECTION OF THE CYSA SURCHARGE

It is a **privilege** for a player to participate on a CYSA competitive team, and each player and/or the parent or guardian **must accept the responsibilities** that result from this participation. One such responsibility is to pay this surcharge fee in a timely manner. The coaching staff of the team **MUST NOT** be made liable for these costs.

Since there has been some problem situations arising with the collection of this surcharge in past years, and so that these surcharge fees will now be collected and forwarded to the CYSA treasurer in an efficient manner, the following criteria will be established beginning in the 2012 season:

- ❑ The surcharge fee will be paid to the team coach at the time that the final team roster is established. Each coach will decide on the type of payment that he/she desires (cash or cheque).
- ❑ The team coach will then forward the ENTIRE team surcharge to the CYSA office in one payment (cash; cheque; debit or credit).
- ❑ **ONLY AFTER** this complete team surcharge payment has been given to the CYSA office will the entire set of new team jerseys for the outdoor season be distributed by the CYSA office to the coaching staff.
- ❑ Failure by a player, or the parent/guardian of a player, to pay this surcharge fee may result in said player removed from the team roster until the matter is resolved. Continued refusal to pay may result in the player being de-registered by the CYSA with no refund being given.
